1) Can bring:

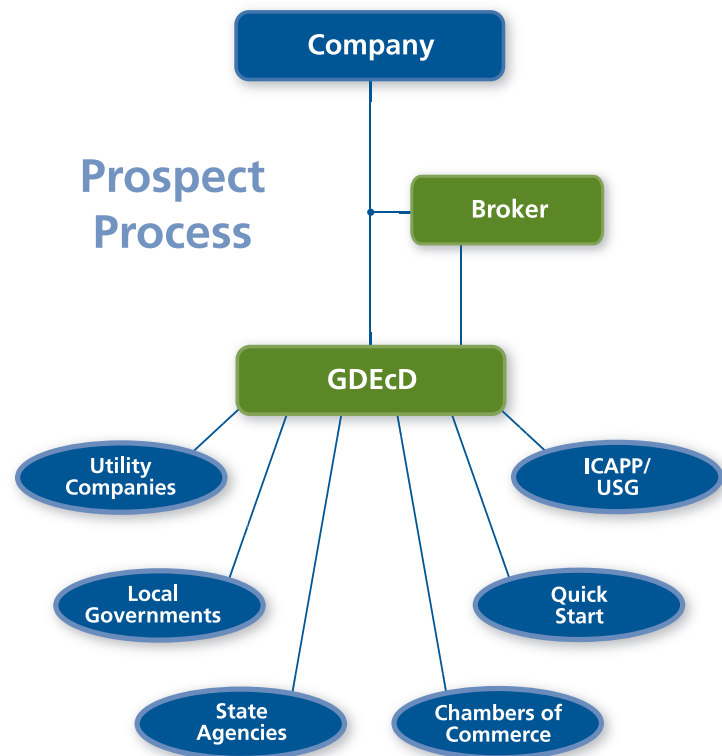
- an up-to-date knowledge of the wide range of resources at Georgia's 35 public colleges and universities,

### *Life Sciences Georgia Strategic Industry*

In response to bioscience industry requests, ICAPP funded the creation of **three graduate programs** in regulatory science and clinical trials at the University of Georgia's College of Pharmacy.

- Graduate Certificate in Regulatory Affairs
- Graduate Certificate in Clinical Trials Design & Management
- Master of Science in Pharmacy–Regulatory Affairs

*Since January 2005:*

- 139 students from 32 Georgia companies and biomedical institutions have enrolled in one of the programs.
- 55 have earned at least one graduate certificate, and 2 have earned the Master of Science in Pharmacy – Regulatory Affairs, with 6 more writing their theses after completing all the required coursework.
